(Times New Roman 11pt from this point forward, two columns, column width 7.5 cm, space between columns 0.5 cm, page margin left 3.5 cm, page margins at top, down and right 2 cm). Please start entering text of your abstract here. “Styles” are defined for the Title, Authors, Affiliation, 1st paragraph, Abstract text, Figure captions, Table captions, Table text and References (you can typically find Styles left-up in the Microsoft Word main screen). Please do not change the layout or style of the template. We ask you kindly to follow the very few rules here explained to let the conference have a Book of Abstract as standardised as possible. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated. For this 1st paragraph please use Style “Text_First_Paragraph”.

The second and subsequent paragraphs should be written here using Style “Text”. The maximum length of the abstract is 2 pages for both oral and posters presentations, whereas for plenary lectures the limit is 8 pages. References to bibliography should be put as showed by a superscript number.¹ The number should always follow the puncture sign, if present.

Leave one line before and after each figure and attach them always as image. Select your figures and put “Figure” as style. The Figure captions should straight follow the Figures without any line and the corresponding style to be used is “Figure_Caption”. Use the style “Figure_Caption+Bold” for the first part of the caption:

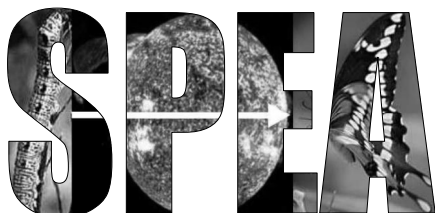


Figure X. Caption of the figure should be put in this part. (Arial 10pt)

The figures will be printed without colour (but the coloured figures will be present in the electronic version of the Book of Abstract).

Hence please take care that Figures are clearly understandable when printed in B/W.

As far as Schemes are concerned the same rules of the Figures should be used. Please **insert all figures and schemes as images** to avoid possible problems with special characters or chemical formula.

Tables should preferably occupy one column of the page. For the caption of the Table Style “Table_Caption” should be used, Use the style “Table_Caption+Bold” for the first part of the caption (“Table XX”).

For the table-text use the Style “Table_Text”. Please leave one line before and one line after the table.

Tables needing the two columns of the page should be used only when strictly necessary. The abstract file name should be in this form: “**Surname.doc**”, where the Surname is that of the Presenting Author.

Acknowledgements and Bibliography sections should be put at the end of the abstract. Leave one line before the titles “Acknowledgements” and “Bibliography”. Please try to put a maximum of 9 references (this advise is not valid for plenary lectures). Use the corresponding styles for articles in journals,¹ conference proceedings,² books,³ articles in books.⁴ For journals abbreviations please use website **Web of Science Journal Title Abbreviations** (http://images.isiknowledge.com/WOK46/help/WOS/0-9_abrvjt.html).

This resource lists the full names of journals in alphabetical order, followed by their abbreviations. We kindly ask you to use that website to correct bibliography styles for the sake of uniformity of Book of Abstract.

Acknowledgements (Arial 12pt)
